Missions Table Talk Information Sheet



There is a chasm of misunderstanding between many pastors and the real-life experiences of many missionaries. The result is an undermining of a church's investment in missionaries. In order to help close the chasm and improve the relationship between missionaries and local churches the Gospel Furthering Fellowship has developed a ministry called "Mission Table Talks."

What is a Missions Table Talk?

A Table Talk is a one-day (9:30 am - 3:30 pm) missions roundtable discussion where important missions topics are presented and discussed.

Who is the Target Audience?

The target audience is Pastors, Missionaries, Missions Influencers and laymen.

Where and when are they held?

They are held at host churches in the fall of the year. We have held Table Talks in PA, IA, CT, VA and NJ.

How much does it cost to attend?

There is no charge to attend. Lunch, coffee breaks, and materials are provided free of charge.

What is expected of the host church?

The host church provides a room to meet in and a room suitable for lunch. Some churches provide coffee and hot water. They also promote the Table Talk in their sphere of influence.

What Subjects are covered?

Some of the subjects that have been covered are Stress and Trauma in the Life of a Missionary, Character Issues such as Narcissism and Pragmatism and their Influence on Missions, Missionary Financing, Missionary Care, and Missionary Sending Responsibility.
